PARKING AND TRAFFIC INFORMATION

Road Closures: There are no road closures as the competition is conducted on the beach or in the ocean. Around the main transition point we do expect congestion in and around the transition points at Burleigh, Kurrawa and Currumbin.

Car Parking: The car parks at all surf clubs are restricted and there will not be public or media parking Available it is strongly suggested to register to have a seat in the two media vehicles.

BEST VANTAGE POINT FOR VIEWING RACES

Greenmount: Finish of the open, Masters and Teams ski leg - the Greenmount Point walkway will be a perfect area to watch the transitions.

Currumbin: Finish of the second open, Masters and Teams run and finish of the female and U19 ski legs.

Burleigh Heads: Finish of all competitors board legs and the start of the final run leg.

Northcliffe: The turning point for both the ski leg and the final run leg before finishing at Kurrawa.

Kurrawa: Start and the finish of all events.

ECKSTEIN AND MARRIOTT HEADLINE COOLANGATTA GOLD'S 10TH ANNIVERSARY RACE

Defending champions **Caine Eckstein** and **Alicia Marriott** will again headline this year's 10th race anniversary of Australia's toughest endurance Ironman race – the iconic Coolangatta Gold, on November 7.

Born within the movie of the same name in 1984, the Coolangatta Gold is now firmly entrenched on the Surf Life Saving Australia and Queensland Events sporting calendar.

After it's debut years in 1984 and 1985 the race returned in 1991 and 1992 before it made yet another return in 2005, this time adding the first women's race won by **Hayley Bateup**.

The event for men over 46.65km and 30.5km for the women also features under 19s, Masters and Teams events which has continued to grow, this year attracting over 500 competitors.

Last year saw Eckstein win a record-breaking third Coolangatta Gold (2005, 2008 and 2009) eclipsing the original two-time winner Guy Leech (1984 and 1985).

To win a fourth Coolangatta Gold will certainly etch his name indelibly into the annals of a race that has continued to capture the imagination of Australians since **Grant Kenny** starred alongside **Colin Friels** and **Josh McWilliam** in **Michael Edgley's** movie.

The men's race will also feature Ironman legend **Dean Mercer** (Northcliffe), **Josh Minogue** and **Jack Hansen** (Mooloolaba), **Mark Simpson** (Cronulla) and **Cory Hill** (Northcliffe).

Last year also saw **Alicia Marriott** take her second women's Gold crown (2007 and 2009) and a third victory in 2010 will see her join Bateup (2005, 2006, 2008) as a three-time winner.

Bateup will miss this year's race after undergoing shoulder reconstruction.

But Marriott can expect some stiff opposition from Northcliffe sister combination **Courtney** and **Bonnie Hancock** and team mate **Elizabeth Plumers**, who is returning after collapsing just before the finishing line last year.

- Ski (Kurrawa to Currumbin SLSC via Northcliffe) 15km;
 - Run (Currumbin SLSC to Currumbin Creek) 1km;
 - Board (Currumbin Creek to Burleigh Heads SLSC) 4.5km;
 - Swim (Burleigh Heads SLSC to North Burleigh) 2.5km;
 - Run (North Burleigh to Kurrawa via Northcliffe) 7.5km

JORDAN KEEPS MERCER NAME IN LIGHTS

The Coolangatta Gold has been synonymous with the Mercer family since **Darren Mercer** first dueled with eventual winner **Michael King** in 1991, eventually winning the famed race in 1992, which saw little brother Dean finish third.

Dean returned in 2005 and has not missed a race since, again finishing third, this time to **Zane Holmes** in 2006 before his best ever result, second to **Caine Eckstein**, who clocked a race record of 4 hours 00.51 in 2009.

Last year also saw Darren Mercer return to the race as the ski paddler in a Mixed team that featured his board-paddling daughter Jordan, the 2009 Female Competitor of the Australian Championships.

But this year Jordan, at 15, will contest the open women's race – the youngest in the field.

TEAMS ATTRACT OLYMPIANS AND TRIATHLETES

The popular teams events have added a real enthusiasm to many clubs from around Australia with Olympians, champion runners and triathletes joining in the Coolangatta Gold festival of sport.

The Dee Why women's team will be spearheaded by Beijing Olympic canoeing silver medallist **Jacqueline Lawrence** while the defending Freshwater men's team will see Ironman Triathlete **Pete Jacobs** join ski-paddling brother Tim.

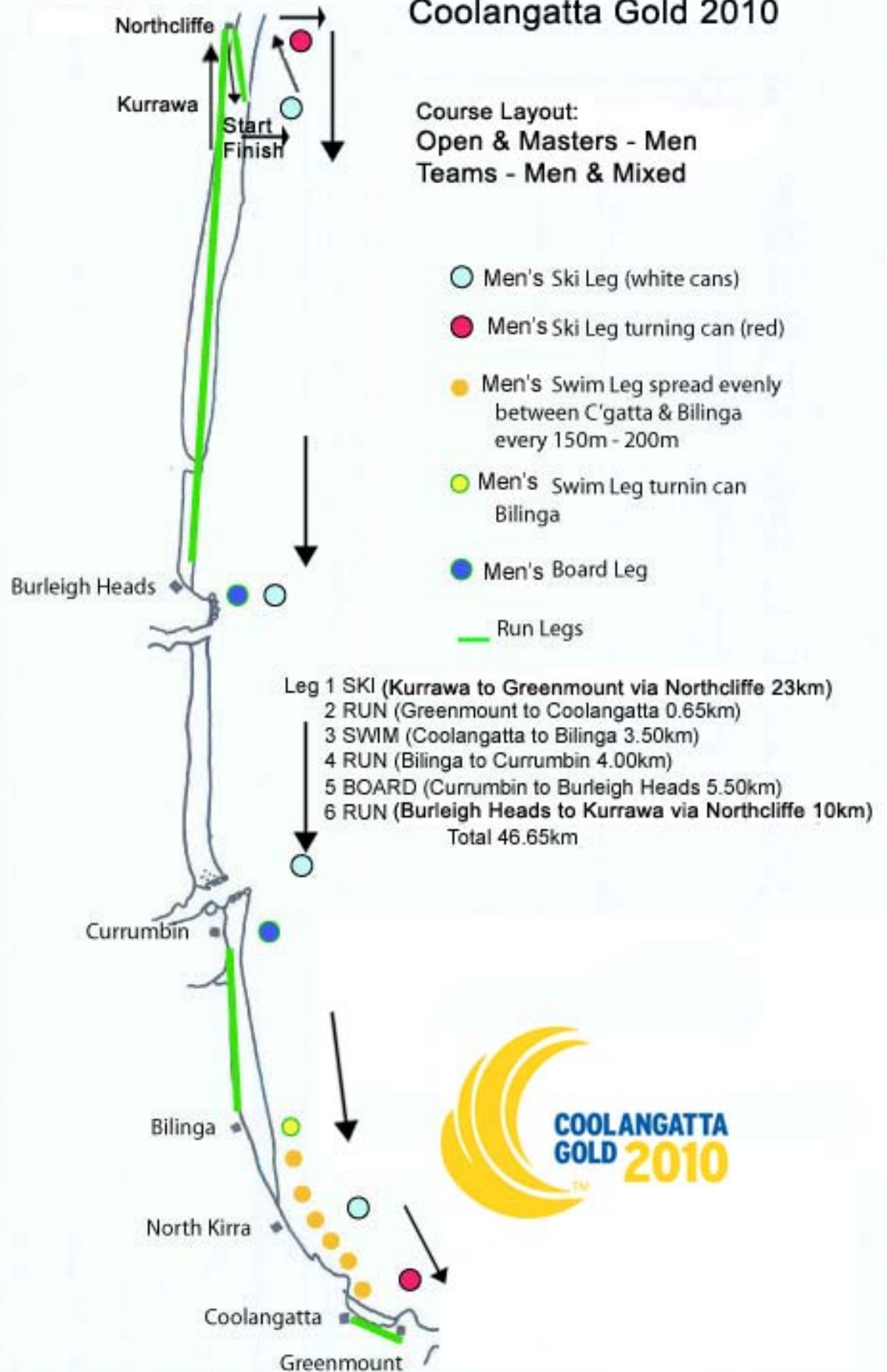

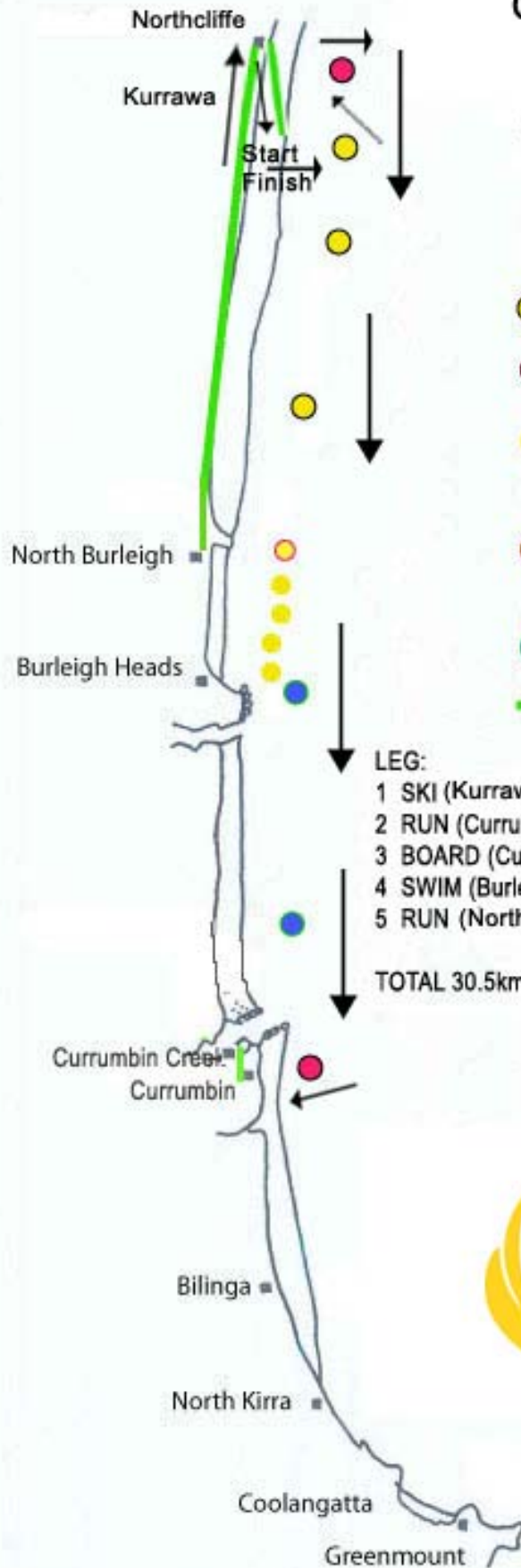
Course Layout:

PROFILE: Has made the Coolangatta Gold his own since the return of the iconic race in 2005 when he surged to beat training partner Jeremy Cotter and brother Shannon to signal his presence as the new breed of endurance Ironman. Returned to win a second Gold in 2008 to maintain his unbeaten run before defending his crown in a race record time of four hours and 51 seconds – keeping Ironman legend Dean Mercer at bay to win an historic third title.

PROFILE: Made his Coolangatta Gold debut in 1991 when he finished fifth to Michael King and will this year line up in his eighth Gold in a race he has been passionate about for over two decades. Finished third to brother Darren in 1992; third to Zane Holmes in 2006 and second to Caine Eckstein in 2009. The winner of two Australian Ironman titles in 1989 and 1995. A true legend of Ironman racing.

Finished sixth in the 2009 Coolangatta Gold and has qualified for his first Kellogg's Nutri-Grain Series in 2010-11.
